


- What in God's revelation should be neglected?

  - Prophecies/promises = proof
  - Sets up NT teaching

## The Old Testament CONTAINS CHRIST

• It preaches on the Gospel. (1 Pet. 1:10-12)

- Isaiah preached the "good news" (Is. 61:1-2; Mt. 11:2-6; Luke 4:18)
- OT Israel heard the "good news" (Heb. 4:1-2, 6; cf. Luke 3:18)
- It preaches on Christ. (Lk. 24:27, 44)
  - Moses foretold Jesus (Deut. 18:15)
  - David saw glimpses of Him (Ps. 110)
  - Isaiah spoke of Jesus' mission (Is. 53)
