The "churches of Christ" are those that submit to His lordship

Paul conveyed greetings to the Christians in Rome when he wrote: "All the churches of Christ greet you" (Rom. 16:16). This statement meant that, at the time Paul wrote, there existed somewhere some other churches, or local congregations, that could properly be called the "churches of Christ." What were these churches? And is it possible for a congregation today to be what they were?

In the most general sense, of course, the "church" is simply the people of Jesus Christ. The church belongs to Christ. He said, "I will build my church" (Mt. 16:18), and Paul said the church is that "which he obtained with his own blood" (Ac. 20:28). "All authority" (Mt. 28:18) has been given to Jesus Christ, and He is "head over all things to the church" (Eph. 1:22,23). The "church" envisioned in these passages is, of course, the universal body of Christ, consisting of all those individuals everywhere who have obeyed the gospel and who live faithfully before the Lord. Membership in this church is a result of being baptized into Christ. "In Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith," Paul wrote to the Christians in Galatia. "For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ" (Gal. 3:26,27).

But what about a "local church," a congregation or assembly of Christians in a specific locality? When a group of individuals, each of whom has been added to the Lord's body in the universal sense, have the common purpose of working and worshiping together, what will make them one of the "churches of Christ"?

The answer is simple: *the "churches of Christ" are those that submit to His lordship.* A congregation cannot be "of Christ" without obeying Him any more than an individual can be a disciple without following His teaching. For that reason, it is urgent that congregations both hear and obey Christ's word: "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches" (Rev. 3:22). This week, let's study the Lord's authority over His churches — and the dire consequences if we disregard His will. Any congregation can say that it is "of Christ." But let's make sure that being "of Christ" (both individually and collectively) is more than a matter of mere words.
