Why Respond?

- > There is a God who created us...
 - In His image (Gen. 1:27)
 - Good (Gen. 1:31)
 - To have a relationship with Him
 - But sin ruined that relationship (Rom. 6:23; 1 John 3:4)
- > But, ALL have sinned against Him, and are in need of a Savior (Rom. 3:23).
- So God sent One (John 3:16)!

How Do We Respond To This?

- Accept, be faithful in, and obedient to that Gospel message (Rom. 1:18-20).
- Repent: Turn to God and away from sin (Acts 26:20; cf. Mt. 16:24-25).
- Confess: Pledge your allegiance/loyalty to Jesus as King (Acts 8:37; Rom. 10:9-10).

You can do all these things, and still fall short of becoming a Christian!

The Final Response

When do we become a Christian?

- Baptism is when we become citizens of His Kingdom (Jn. 3:3-5; cf. Eph. 5:26; Tit. 3:5)
- ...is the moment of conversion (Acts 2:38; 10:46-48; 22:16)
- ...is the moment we're recreated (Jn. 3:3-5; 2 Cor. 5:17; Col. 3:1, 10)
- ...is when the old man is put to death and the new man is put on (Rom. 6:1-6)
- ...is the moment we're washed (1 Pet. 3:21; cf. Jn. 3:3-5; Acts 22:16)
- ...is the moment we "put on Christ" (Gal. 3:27)
