
PAUL AT CORINTH



- 1Cor. 2:1 ¶ And when I came to you, brethren, I did not come with superiority of speech or of wisdom, proclaiming to you the testimony of God.
- ² For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified.
- ³ I was with you in weakness and in fear and in much trembling,
- ⁴ and my message and my preaching were not in persuasive words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power,
- ⁵ so that your faith would not rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power of God.

- That I am only permitted to herald the King's command
